

Immersive Academic and Cultural Programs at U.S. Universities

Overview:

I4 LLC (I4) partners with U.S. universities to offer exclusive 2-3 week immersive academic and cultural programs. These programs allow students to:

- Meet faculty and peers
- Attend university classes
- Participate in on- and off-campus exploration
- Engage in a multi-module workshop on Leadership and Innovation
- Receive a signed certificate of engagement from university leadership

Additionally, students will have the opportunity to meet with university admissions representatives to discuss the pathway to enrollment and receive a conditional offer of admission, setting them apart from other candidates and enhancing their chances for university admission and scholarships.

I4 covers all expenses for local transportation, housing, and meals, which are organized through the partnering universities. Upon arrival, students will be greeted at the airport and transferred to the university campus, where they will be housed for the duration of their stay. Three meals per day are provided on campus, and university transportation is available for off-campus activities. After the program concludes, students will be transferred back to the airport for their return journey.

Below is a tentative itinerary for the Leadership and Innovation program, offered by I4 in collaboration with Emporia State University (ESU) for June 3rd through 16th.
